

How to Commission Artwork

If you would like to have a commission and don't really know where to start here are a few things for you to consider.

First, is the art for the wall, or your own jacket or any other form of artwork? For example I have painted on handbags, panel from an aircraft, luggage cases and small complete leather hides. Customers can be so inventive with their ideas!

Decide on what sort of image you want to have, even if you do not have a full idea, some guidelines would help, we can discuss and refine it through text, email and images. Is there something similar that you have seen?

For wall art what size do you need? We do offer an in-house framing service or you can get the item framed yourself. It is your choice.

How would you like your artwork to be created? On canvas board, paper, leather hide? Drawn or painted? Oil or acrylic paint? (Jackets and leather can only be painted).

Do you have a deadline? Oil paintings need at least 3 months to dry before they can be shipped.

I will provide a formal no-obligation quote that will detail the charges, terms and conditions. An initial deposit will be required. My prices are in line with the artwork for sale on this website - I do not charge extra for personal commissions.

The whole design process from start to completion is a step by step collaboration between us both.

Upon completion you can decide if you wish to arrange collection of the artwork, have it delivered by Royal Mail (subject to size restrictions) or sent to you by DHL. If we dispatch your artwork, it is always sent fully insured. Please see our Terms and Conditions for full details.
