

Jacket Artwork

Most people tend to have an idea of what they want painting on their jacket. If you give me a few ideas, I can digitally put some artwork together for you to look at. If you can email or text me a photo of the back of your own jacket/waistcoat, I can superimpose the artwork on it so that you will get an idea as to how it will look. You may decide to make it bigger/smaller or add lettering.

Once you have roughly agreed on the artwork composition I will give you a quotation. You can make changes and I will requote. When you are happy with it all, then you send me your jacket in the post (I always advise making sure it is sent special delivery insured). As soon as I receive your jacket, I will check that it is suitable to paint (I haven't had to refuse a jacket yet!) double check the artwork details with you and give you a fixed price (which will be the same as the quotation if no changes have been made).

As soon as you are happy and wish to proceed I will take a 50% deposit from you which you can do by paying direct in to my account, giving your credit card details to me over the phone or PayPal. You are entitled to a 14 day 'cooling off period' but if you wish to waive this, I will start your artwork as soon as my schedule allows.

I will always tell you when I can start painting your jacket and when you can expect to receive it completed before any money is exchanged.

I take photographs throughout the creation of your artwork to keep a record of the progress and I can keep you updated if you wish. Some customers prefer to wait until the item is finished. Once your jacket is almost complete, I will send you images so that you can make any final tweaks. As soon as the jacket is finished the remainder of the money is due including return postage. Once the account is settled in full, I will post your jacket back to you.
